AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR.

WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP.

SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

R & J Arena Direction

From south of east take MN Highway 10 (4 lanes) to Verndale, MN. Show facility on right side of highway just after Verndale or if coming from west it will be on left side of highway just before Verndale.

From southwest take MN Highway 71 to Wadena, MN turn right onto Highway 10 and proceed 6.2 miles, the facility will be on left just before coming into Verndale.

From north on Highway 71 turn left onto Highway 10 and proceed 6.2 miles, the facility will be on left coming into Verndale.

**READ ME!
ENTRY & POST ENTRY INFORMATION**

- * Pre-entry deadline, postmarked by **May 2nd, 2025**.
- * Please use the NMAHA entry form with **ONE** horse per form. Both shows can be entered on the same form.
- * Include with completed entry form – send to show secretary
 - Fully negotiable check or money order in US funds
 - Current copy of negative Coggins certificate. Bring original to the show.
 - Stabling form (can be emailed or mailed in advance of entry forms)
- * Bring to the show
 - Copy of horse’s registration papers, with current owner listed.
 - Copy of current AHA membership cards for each owner, rider/handler, and trainer, WITH required competition endorsement.
 - Copy of USEF amateur certification (adult amateurs)
- * Entries postmarked after **May 2nd** or made at the show will be charged post entry fees as listed below.
- * If you pre-enter a horse in a *minimum of one class* (postmarked on or before May 2, you can enter that same horse in additional classes at the pre-entry fee rate.
- * Post entries will be accepted up to the start of the session in which the class being entered is scheduled.
- * Anyone wanting to establish a show tab must leave a blank, signed check with the show secretary.

STABLING & ELECTRICAL HOOKUPS

- * Every horse on the grounds is required to have a separate stall; no showing out of a trailer.
 - Box stalls are roughly 10’ x 8’. Stalls are on a tar-based footing and all stalls have doors.
 - Please use the separate stabling form. The stabling form can be emailed or mailed to show secretary in advance of horse entry forms.
 - Indoor hot water wash areas.
- * Barns will open at 9:00 am on Friday, May 16th.
- * Barns will be open Thursday for early arrival. Please list this on the stabling form. There is an additional \$15 charge **per stall used** (horse and tack stalls) for early arrival.
- * Please contact Roz Gilbert for any questions about early arrival or assignment of stall location.
- * Electrical hookups for motor homes and trailers are available with 30-amp and 50-amp service. There are no water hookups. Fee is \$30 per day. The stabling form includes the electrical hookup reservation information.
- * If you do not use an electrical hookup, trailer/camper parking is free.

HIGH POINT AWARDS

- NMAHA High-Point belt buckles will be awarded to the Arabian and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian horse that earns the most points over the weekend. More than one rider/handler can earn points for the same horse.
- Schooling classes, Poker In-hand Trail, and Leadline classes do not count towards the high-point awards.
- In addition, thanks to a sponsor, Working Western High Point Buckles also will be awarded. Information is on page 9.

**Showmanship Clinic
Saturday May 17th, 2025
Sheri Odom**

Everyone is welcome to listen to Sheri, a National Judge, discuss showmanship. She will also cover the showmanship card as well.

No Fee to attend, do not have to be showing.

General Information

- 1. Office Hour:** Friday Noon until 9:00 p.m. Saturday and Sunday 7:00 a.m. until one hour after end of the last class
- 2. Refunds:**
 - Vet outs: Entry fee refunds will be made only with the receipt of a vet certificate by the show secretary prior to the end of show day. The office fee will be retained for any horse vetted out in advance of or during the show week
 - Stabling fees refunds will be made at the discretion of show management
 - Any authorized refunds will be sent by mail after the show.
- 3. Junior Exhibitors:** Junior Exhibitor classes are limited to riders/handlers who have not yet reached their 19th birthday, determined as of December 1, 2024. Junior 14 years and under are not allowed to show stallions in any in-hand, performance halter, or showmanship classes.
- 4. Combined Arabian/Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian classes:** the rider/handler may show either an Arabian, Half-Arabian or Anglo Arabian in Equitation, Western Horsemanship, Showmanship, Leadline, Walk/Trot-Jog and In-Hand Poker Trail
- 5. AHA Membership:** current AHA membership with competition card is required of all owners, agents, riders/drivers/handlers, trainers EXCEPT Walk/Trot 10 & Under exhibitors, Leadline riders, and parents/guardians signing for minors.
- 6. Required signatures:** only adults can sign an entry form. A parent/guardian needs to sign for junior exhibitors. The trainer is any adult responsible for the care and custody of that horse while at the show and that person must be present at the show.
- 7. TBA classes:** A limited number of TBA slots are included in our class schedule. Submit any request for a TBA class to the show secretary no later than April 15th. The decision on which TBA requests will be accepted will be announced soon after April 15th and will be based on number of exhibitors requesting the same or very similar class. TBA classes can be chosen from the AHA class lists **EXCEPT for the following divisions: Sport Horse, Dressage, Western Dressage, classes requiring cattle, Carriage Driving Jumping or Hunter/Hunter Seat Equitation Over Fences.** There is a \$15 TBA fee per class
- 8. In-hand Poker Trail class:** open to Arabian/Half-Arabians/Anglo-Arabians. Horses will be shown in either a stable halter or a bridle. The course will consist of five trail obstacles. At the satisfactory completion of each obstacle, the handler will draw playing card, which will be announced. At the completion of the class, the handler with the best poker hand wins the \$200 prize money. In the case of a tie, the tied handles will each draw one card; high card winning the prize money
- 9. Roll of the Dice classes:** at the start of each show day, the show committee will draw ten (10) junior exhibitor and amateur classes that will be designated Roll of the Dice classes. Prior to the judge's placing each of these ten classes, the announcer will state the class is a "Roll of the Dice" class and will roll a die. Whatever number rolled (1 – 6) will be the placing that receives \$50, collected at the show office at the end of that class session.
- 10. Schooling classes:** Work tack and informal clothing is allowed; riding boots are required. Horses will be required to perform at a walk, trot/jog, and canter/lope both directions of the ring; they may be required to stop and stand quietly and/or back. Entries will be judged on performance, manners, and suitability, in that order.
- 11. Bedding:** make any requests for bedding, in addition to what was pre-ordered, at the show office; delivery will be made by Event Arena staff: You are not allowed to bring your own bedding.
- 12. Dogs:** all dogs must be held on a leash or otherwise contained. They are not permitted to be loose on the competition grounds.
- 13. Stabling:** Every horse on the grounds must have a separate stall; no showing out of a trailer. No stall assigned to you may be used by another exhibitor unless approved by the show manager.
- 14. Rules:** Unless specified otherwise, classes will be conducted following the current USEF Arabian Division rules and the AHA Value Show Rules.
- 15. Age splits:** JTR and AATR classes will be split by age if more than 12 horses are properly entered in the class at the start of the class session. There will be separate awards for each class.
- 16. Call for Classes:** While every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system, exhibitors are responsible for knowing when their class is going into the ring. First call will be given during the second preceding class. Second call will be given during the preceding class. Third call will be given at the time the preceding class is lined up. For classes where exhibitors compete collectively, two minutes are allowed after the first horse enters the arena.
- 17. Non-showing horses:** All horses on the showgrounds must be registered in the show office. Non-showing horses must have separate stall and will be charged for stall fees. All rules applicable to horses being shown also apply to non-showing horses.
- 18. Credit card transactions:** If you wish to utilize a credit card to pay for entries, stabling/bedding, patronships and/or class sponsorships, please complete the NMAHA Credit Card form and include it with your entries. In order to cover the costs of credit card transactions, a 3% convenience fee will be added to the total amount due for show expenses
- 19. PRINTING ERRORS:** If any errors are found in the prize list, corrections will be posted in the Show Office.
